For Candidates Pursuing a Certificate, Diploma or Degree in Civil Engineering, Environmental Engineering, Transportation Engineering, Public Works Management or other applicable program

The Ontario Public Works Association (OPWA) is a not-for-profit educational and membership organization whose purpose shall be the advancement of the theory and practice of the design, construction, maintenance, administration, and operation of public works facilities and services; the dissemination of information and experience, and the promotion of improved practices in public works administration; the encouragement of the adherence by public works officials to a high professional standard; and the professional and social improvements of its members; and the promotion of cooperation among all public, quasi-public, and private persons, firms, corporations, bodies, utilities, and agencies which have interests in the field of public works.

ROW Management Committee is sponsoring a scholarship program for Candidates pursuing a certificate, diploma or degree in Civil Engineering, Environmental Engineering, Transportation Engineering or Public Works Management.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS:

Application forms are available on the ROW Management website, <u>rowmanagement.ca</u> and on the OPWA web site at <u>Ontario.cpwa.net</u>. Applicants may reapply yearly for scholarship awards, provided a new application is submitted each time.

ELIGIBILITY:

Students who plan to attend an accredited university or college during the Fall 2023 Semester at the undergraduate level whose major course of study encompasses the field of Civil or Environmental Engineering, Transportation Engineering, Public Works Administration or other programs within the public works field are eligible. Students may be part time or full time at colleges or universities; however, candidates must be seeking a certificate, diploma or degree. Candidates must reside in Ontario.

Active members of the OPWA ROW Scholarship Sub-Committee Committee and their family members are ineligible.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE:

Candidates who receive monies from other sources are eligible to apply for this award.

AWARD AMOUNT:

ROW Management Committee will be offering **three (3) - \$1000 scholarships**. The ROW Management Committee reserves the right to not issue a scholarship if no submitted application is deemed to indicate a scholarship is warranted.

- 1. **High School Senior**: Awarded to a high school senior who will be attending an accredited university or college. Student should be pursuing an education in a public works related field.
- 2. **College Student**: Awarded to a college student who is currently enrolled at an accredited college or university, seeking a certificate, diploma or degree in Civil Engineering, Environmental Engineering, Transportation Engineering, Public Works Management or other applicable program.
- 3. **University Student**: Awarded to a university student who is currently enrolled at an accredited college or university, seeking a certificate, diploma or degree in Civil Engineering, Environmental engineering, Transportation Engineering, Public Works Management or other applicable program.
